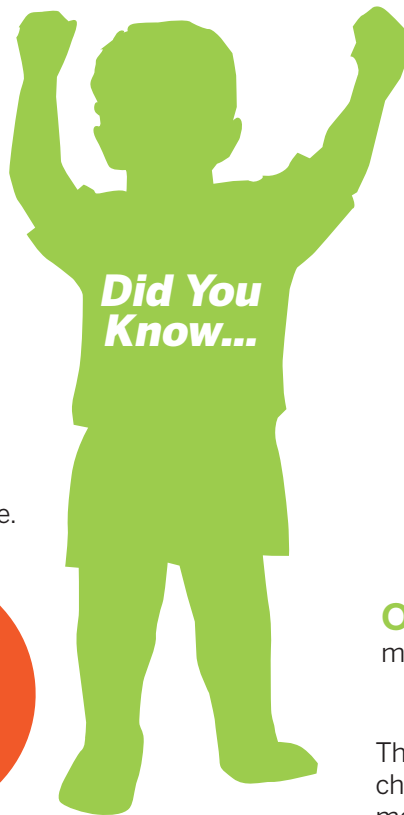


Early Childhood Mental Health Collaborative

Supporting Early Care and Education



Children in preschool are expelled at **three times the rate** of children in K-12.



Over one-quarter of Orange County early education providers have behavior or mental health concerns about a child they serve.

Over one-third have had to expel a child from their program for problematic behavior.



Only one-third of children with a mental health condition get any treatment.

There is typically a **7 year delay** between children showing symptoms and actually getting mental health treatment. We can do better.

The Opportunity:

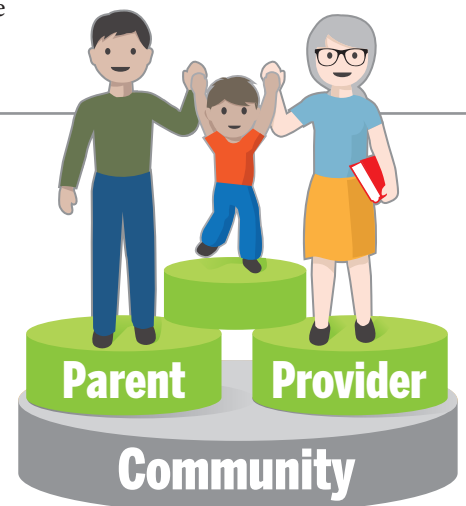
Reaching young children through caregivers and early educators

- Promote earlier identification of young children who need intervention
- Partner with early education to increase capacity to support children and keep them in care
- Integrate early education into the existing behavior and mental health system of care

What we are doing

The ECMHC was formed to address these issues collectively and in partnership with Orange County organizations that seek to make these opportunities a reality. Our group is working on programming to integrate:

- Early Education Provider Training
- Parent Education
- On-Site Consultation
- Referrals
- Clinical Assessment & Services
